JASON PATRIC'S STAND UP FOR GUS AND LEVITT & QUINN FAMILY LAW CENTER HOST PRESS CONFERENCE IN OBSERVANCE OF PARENTAL ALIENATION AWARENESS DAY

Founder of Stand Up For Gus, Activist and Actor Jason Patric joins government supporters of the organizations to highlight critical need for change

LOS ANGELES, April 9, 2014 – Today, Stand Up For Gus, a non-profit organization dedicated to raising monetary support for alienated parents desperately trying to maintain a meaningful relationship with their children, and the Levitt & Quinn Family Law Center, a non-profit public interest firm providing legal services and representation to low and moderate income clients with family law cases in Los Angeles County, announced that they will be holding a press conference on Friday, April 25th to announce their partnership to provide free legal representation to parents seeking to be part of their children's lives.

The scheduled press conference will be on Friday, April 25th at 11:00A.M. located on the south lawn at Los Angeles City Hall (200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012).

"While I wish I didn't have to be here in this circumstance, I am," said Patric. "I share the pain and injustice of all parents who have had a child abducted or turned against them by an alienating partner. But it must be a community of hope, because our children need to feel that as much as we do. I would not miss this opportunity to express how much hope I have in my heart, that I will holding my son Gus very soon, and telling him not only how much I love him, but how his very name has now brought faith and inspiration to so many."

The partnership between Stand Up For Gus and Levitt Quinn Family Law Center provides an opportunity to use both organizations' resources to build awareness of parent alienation and to ensure stability for children and their families involved in family law matters, through representation, education and outreach.

Seeking solutions to what is becoming an increasingly common phenomenon, Jason Patric will speak on his story, the Stand Up For Gus organization, and how the community can help support the cause with a goal to continually raise funds for low-income families in situations similar to his and to challenge one lawyer and/or law firm from across the country to support the cause in each of their states.

During the press conference, Jason Patric will present Levitt & Quinn Family Law Center with a \$100,000 pledge to continue to provide legal services and resources to low-income individuals engaged in family law and custody disputes. In addition to Jason Patric, members from the Levitt Quinn Family Law Center, Councilman Jose Huizar will also be in attendance.
