Help educate families about their legal rights and responsibilities as you develop your client interviewing skills and fulfill pro bono graduation requirements.

After a brief orientation, students will work under the supervision of a Levitt & Quinn attorney, and in partnership with staff from Jenesse Center, to:

- interview clinic participants about their legal issues
- consult with the clinic supervising attorney to craft personalized legal plans and referral packets for clinic participants
- give legal advice under attorney supervision
- work closely with social justice professionals committed to providing high quality legal help to low-income communities
